The building was built in the 1970s by Mohammed Maliyah one Iraqi architect that influence modern architecture in Bahrain, Gulf, and others near contraries. The building had seven floors, the Frist two floor was commercial (Ground and First Floor) and the other five floors were typical apartment floors. It had 49 shops total on the Ground and First Floor and 15 apartments on each typical floor.
